

Using Forbrugsforeningscard at eCommerce merchants.

This document is a short description of what is needed for implementing the Forbrugsforeningscard (FB-card) at eCommerce merchants.

The FB-Card is a Danish national Private Label Card and it is issued by Forbrugsforeningen in Denmark.

All IPSPs, which are connected to the Payment Gateway (PGW) do have the possibility of accepting the popular card from Forbrugsforeningen, as this card is already implemented on this platform today.

The following items needs to be done in order, to accept the card:

- The merchant must sign a merchant agreement with Forbrugsforeningen.
- The Merchant must ask their IPSP to implement FB-Card
- The IPSP must implement Forbrugsforeningen's card scheme on their payment window. Please see the BIN of the card below:
- The following data are mandatory for the FB-Card:
 - 16 digits of PAN starting with 600722
 - Expiry date 4 digits
 - CVV 3 digits
- All transaction must be in Danish kroner DKK, and the merchant must have Denmark as country code (208).
- When transactions with FB-Card are send to Nets, the card is validated as any other accepted card.
- The merchants are settled as agreed with Forbrugsforeningen.
- The IPSP can send test transactions to Nets by using the existing test environment. Test card can be acquired by contacting Nets.

Please be aware that the card is fully and mandatory supported by 3D secure/Secured by Nets.
